

Program Presenter – Water on the Go!

This position performs various educational demonstrations and programs for the museum and outreach visitors. This will include delivering educational programs to school groups, and offsite classrooms throughout Michigan. Responsibilities include: Presentation of programs to public and school audiences on a regular basis, including overnight travel throughout Michigan. Be responsible for the daily care and maintenance of equipment used. Will facilitate offsite programs which require driving a CIS vehicle. Other duties as assigned. Requirements: High School Diploma or GED required, along with a minimum of two years of college level environmental, biological, geological or other relevant science courses. An undergraduate degree in environmental education or a related life science field is a plus. An understanding of and interest in existing statewide initiatives related to water ecology, watershed studies or Great Lakes advocacy. Strong Organizational Skills. Proficiency in Microsoft Word, Excel and PowerPoint, with ability to create effective, engaging presentation and materials. Experience working with children and adults in a formal or informal setting. Mature and professional attitude; reliable. Enthusiasm for the subject and an eagerness to share that enthusiasm with learners of all ages. Experience with upper elementary and middle school students preferred. Knowledge of one or more areas of science is preferred. A valid driver's license with satisfactory driving record is required. **Schedules for Program Presenter WOG will primarily be during school days however may require weekend, and/or evening assignment on occasion. The position works 30-40 hours per week through June, 2019. Hours could be as early as 5am and as late as 11pm.**
