

Summary of Duties: The Camp Director oversees one grade band of Explore Camp: K, 1-2, or 3-4. Camp Directors organize activities, train staff, answer radio calls requesting assistance (supplies, support, etc.), order and organize supplies, and serve as the primary point of contact with camp families.

Required Qualifications: Undergraduate degree or higher in an area of science/education. Previous curriculum planning experience and experience teaching youth (especially preschool or elementary). Strong customer service, interpersonal, active listening, and public speaking skills. 18+ years of age.

Preferred: Certification in elementary education.
